Don Wiles Honored with Tree Planting

The City of Dodge City Parks and Recreation Advisory Board, along with Parks and Facilities staff, hosted a tree-planting ceremony in recognition of Don Wiles on Thursday, July 23, 2020, in Beeson Arboretum / AMBUCS Park. This event was initially scheduled as part of the annual Arbor Day festivities that takes place in April. Don Wiles was chosen by the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board as their 2020 honoree to celebrate his many contributions to our community over the years.

Don moved to Dodge City in the fall of 1956 and served as the Ford County Extension Agent for 42 years. He was an original member of the shade tree commission when created in 1976 and was recognized by the state forester at the time as the first County Agent to promote the use of shade trees in a community. He encouraged the planting of Linden trees, which is one of the most common trees planted by the Forestry and Landscape division throughout City parks today.
